1. Reflect on and improve your playwork practice

2. Support and improve the work of your playwork team

#### **Support the Development of Playwork Opportunities in the Community**

1. Communicate with people in the community about your work
2. Support positive links and partnerships with other organisations and individuals

### **F37D 04**

#### **Contribute to Supporting Disabled Children and Young People in the Play Environment**

1. Plan and prepare for playwork with disabled children and young people
2. Carry out playwork and disabled children and young people

### **F37E 04**

#### **Support Work with Parents and Carers in the Play Environment**

1. Contribute to working relationships with parents and carers
2. Support the involvement of parents and carers in the play environment

### **F37F 04**

#### **Carry Out Playwork in a School Setting**

1. Establish a play space within the school setting
2. Facilitate play in a school setting

### **F37G 04**

#### **Contribute to the Administration of the Play Environment**

1. Process financial transactions
2. Provide and collect information relevant to the play environment
3. Maintain records

### **G37H 04**

#### **Support the Travel of Children and Young People Outside the Play Environment**

1. Support the arrival and departure of children and young people
2. Support children and young people during travel
